

TOWN OF SILVER CREEK
REOPENED ANNUAL MEETING
AUGUST 21, 2012

The Annual Meeting of the Town of Silver Creek, in the County of Lake, and State of Minnesota, at the Silver Creek Town Hall was reopened on the 21st day of August 2012 and was called to order at 7:31 p.m. by Mike Hoops.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the possibility of increasing the Township Levy as a result of the road repair costs we have incurred due to the June 2012 storm.

It was discussed that our costs to repair our storm damaged roads is already in excess of \$200,000. Additionally, we have reduced our levy over the past three years by approximately \$80,000. The Township does not know how much of our costs that FEMA will in fact reimburse, and they are limited to 75% of the costs needed to return the site to a pre-disaster condition.

It was discussed that this year, as we had in the past, we cut our Road & Bridge budget by \$23,000. It was said that if we restore that \$23,000, it is the most justifiable.

Motion by Greg Hull, second by Mike Hoops to increase the Road & Bridge levy for the year 2013 by \$23,000. Carried unanimously.

A constituent relayed to Hoops that he was all in favor of increasing our levy in order to recover some of our costs associated with the storm.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 7:39 upon motion by Greg Hull, second Larry Lampart. Carried unanimously.
