

**TOWN OF SILVER CREEK  
SPECIAL MEETING – Cross Cartway Site Tour  
December 8, 2012**

The Town Board held a special site tour meeting, beginning at the intersection of County Highway 3 and the entrance to Aspen Road, Silver Creek, MN, on Saturday, December 8, 2012, at 7:30 a.m. The purpose of this site tour was to view the Cross cartway petitioner's primary cartway route identified within the original Cross Cartway Application, as well as a tour of alternate route(s) that may be available to us.

Present were Supervisors – Mike Hoops, Greg Hull, Larry Lampart; Clerk Frederick R. Whitney; and Larry Saur, Paul Bauman.

No audio was kept of this special meeting.

Hoops called the meeting to order at 7:30 am

Hull made a motion to conduct a Special Meeting on Tuesday, December 18, 2012, at 6:15 p.m. for the purposes of discussing cartway application and decision making methodology for determining the viability of potential cartway routes. Lampart second the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The entire party began the tour along the proposed cartway path running up to the petitioner's property at the intersection of Christiansen, Saur, Cross and Ricard properties. The soil conditions were noted. The slope and conditions of the terrain and elevations were noted. Geo-coordinates were entered by Greg Hull. White pine tree stands were noted and observed along the route. While staying on the petitioner's property, we continued due south along the lot line between the Cross and Christiansen properties to approximately half way along their section. We viewed the John Christiansen property to the west. We viewed what we had been told and could see on a Landview Mapping, the roughed in road that terminates some 100 feet from where we stood. This possible alternative today runs from County Road 3, easterly towards the petitioner's property and then stops roughly 100 feet from the lot eastern lot line. From this point, we continued through the petitioner's property southeasterly to the southeast property line to where we noted the Pine Ridge Development alternative could be located.

Motion by Hull, second by Lampart to adjourn the meeting at 9:06 a.m. Carried unanimously.
