CASTLE DANGER SUBORDINATE SERVICE DISTRICT MEETING  
September 1, 2015

The Castle Danger Subordinate Service District meeting of The Town Board was held on Tuesday, September 1, 2015 at the Town Hall. Present were Supervisors – Mike Hoops, Greg Hull, Larry Guentzel; Clerk – Kristina Pirsig

Hoops called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

**WASTEWATER OPERATOR'S QUARTERLY REPORT: September 1, 2015**

**Influent**

June – Received 0.7818 million gallons of influent

July - Received 0.9767 million gallons of influent

August – Received 0.9613 million gallons of influent

The district received 0.2216 million gallons of trucked in wastewater during this same period.

**Effluent**

June – 1.71 million gallons of water irrigated

July – 3.847 million gallons of water irrigated

August – 2.897 million gallons of water irrigated

Total irrigated this season is 11.314 million gallons.

Influent flows are down slightly for the quarter.

Irrigation is in great shape for the year. I was able to play off the last year's low carry over and now have the ponds very low for the upcoming year. Of course heavy rainfall could change that quickly. Approximately 2 weeks of irrigation left.

John Frischmann install at 2764 Hwy 61 is 95% complete. He needs to have the wiring connected to the panel before we can install and program the pump. He will also need to have his surveyor run survey for easement on the driveway, the line, the grinder station and access to grinder station. This easement will need to be recorded on property deed. I'm suggesting that we bill him for work completed with the understanding this is a partial payment.

Note above that we now include a driveway access as part of our easement. Tom Wilmus recently called me and requested that we no longer drive on his driveway, but instead use the easement the discharge line follows. He would also like to have his own grinder station and not share with the neighbors. Will discuss this further.

Rustic Inn has completed work necessary to intercept grease from the restaurant. This has certainly seemed to clean up the grease problem associated to the business.

Normal routine maintenance completed. Pumps being changed out seems to be normal We do have an adequate supply of pumps on hand.

All monthly reports and sampling were done and submitted to MPCA in a timely fashion.

My Class C Operator License was renewed for 3 years on July 1, 2015.
