

TOWN OF SILVER CREEK
SPECIAL MEETING
JUNE 14, 2016

A special meeting was held on Tuesday, June 14, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall for the purpose of reviewing the proposals for the building additions of Office Space, Pump Shop and Cold Storage. Present were Supervisors –Larry Guentzel, Michael Hoops, Greg Hull; Clerk – Kristina Pirsig; Morton Buildings, Inc – Craig Nelson..

Proposals for the Cold Storage Building were opened first. Lindquist Buildings submitted a bid of \$52,138.00. Morton Buildings, Inc. submitted a bid of \$69,008.00.

Motion by Hoops, seconded by Hull to look at the bids until the next meeting, Tuesday, June 21, 2016, and award the bid then. Motion carried unanimously.

Proposals for the Pump Shop was opened. Morton Building, Inc submitted a bid of \$56,629.00.

Motion by Hoops, seconded by Hull to look at the bids until next meeting, Tuesday, June 21, 2016, and award the bid then. Motion carried unanimously.

Proposals for the Office/Meeting Spaced was opened. Morton Building, Inc submitted a bid of \$54,897.00.

Motion by Hull, seconded by Guentzel to look at the bids until next meeting, Tuesday, June 21, 2016, and award the bid then. Motion carried unanimously.

Craig Nelson from Morton Building, Inc supplied the Board of Supervisors with a few additional items that could be added to the bid price if they decided they wanted them.

Board instructed the Clerk to email the bid information to them for review.

Discussion was had about the Pavilion and the insurance coverage that should be added. Board instructed the Clerk to have the Pavilion property insurance be increased to a total of \$50,000 to \$60,000.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 8:55 p.m. upon motion by Hull, second Hoops. Carried unanimously.
