

**NOTICE SETTING FORTH INITIAL DESCRIPTIONS
AND SETTING HEARING DATE**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Silver Creek Township, Lake County, Minnesota was requested to set a date for a hearing of the Cross Cartway petition requesting a cartway to access landlocked property;

WHEREAS, the petition contained a description of the desired cartway, the names of the owners over which the desired cartway would pass, and the point of beginning, general course, and termination of the desired cartway;

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 164.07, subd. 2 requires the Town Board to make an order describing as nearly as practicable the desired cartway to be granted, describing the several tracts of land through which the desired cartway will pass, and fixing a time and place when and where the Town Board will meet and act upon the petition;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The desired cartway location is described as: beginning from Aspen Road which now terminates at the SW corner of the NW ¼ of section 21 and would run on the southerly line on the E side of Duane Ricard's 20 acre parcel # 29-5310-20200 described as E ½ of SE ¼ of NE ¼ for approximately 1,320 feet and on the west side of Lyle D. Saur & Patricia Saur's 10 acres described as parcel # 29-5310-21385 approximately 660 feet and on the west side of Larry J. & Colleen Saur's 10 acre parcel # 29-5310-21400 SW ¼ of SW ¼ of NW ¼ for 660 feet. A more specific description may be developed if the petition is granted.
2. The several tracts of land through which the desired cartway will pass and their owners are:

3. The Silver Creek Town Board will conduct a hearing at 6:00 p.m. on the 24th day of September, 2012, at 1891 Town Road, Two Harbors, MN 55616 to receive public comment, take testimony, consider the proposed action, and act on the petition.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

Affected landowners have right of appeal as provided in Minn. Stat. § 164.07, subd. 7 to seek judicial review of damages, need, and purpose if the Town Board does decide to grant the desired cartway.
