The place of filing for federal offices is the Office of the Secretary of State, State Office Building, Room 180, 100 Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., St. Paul, MN 55155-1299. The place of filing for state offices is with the Office of the Secretary of State or with the County Auditor of the county in which the candidate resides. The place of filing for county offices is with the office of the County Auditor.

Candidates may file in person or by mail if the filing is received during the filing period. Candidates who will be absent from the state during the filing period and meet the requirements of Minnesota Statutes section 204B.09, subdivision 1a may arrange to file during the seven days immediately preceding the candidate's absence from the state.

The filing period begins May 22, 2018 at 8:00 a.m. and ends June 5, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. County Auditor office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. The office will be closed Monday, May 28 in observance of the Memorial Day holiday and will remain open until 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 5, 2018.
